AGMP is a network of Anglican global mission-committed organizations and individuals including mission agencies, dioceses, missionaries, institutions, and jurisdictions in North America. AGMP is a voluntary partnership that has relationships with various Episcopal and Anglican ecclesial structures committed to world mission, but is not within any of those structures.

AGMP was established in the fall of 2003 to provide a network for biblical, mission-minded Anglican entities to advance the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the very ends of the earth. We covenant to work together in every way possible to bless one another's unique ministries, to create missionary partnerships, to encourage missionary vocations among young people, to raise up new generations of missionaries, to increase the efficiency and impact of our missionary endeavors, and faithfully to make disciples of all nations.

AGMP believes and confesses that Jesus Christ is the Way, the Truth, and the Life and that the Bible is God's Word Written and contains all things necessary to salvation. AGMP holds to the essentials of Anglicanism as outlined in the Book of Common Prayer, the 39 Articles, and the Chicago-Lambeth Quadrilateral.

Our mission is to collaborate with Anglican bodies in cross-cultural mission through exhorting, equipping, sending and receiving in ways that increase the impact of one another's ministries and the entire Body of Christ. Our vision is to see an Anglican Church in North America that is passionately committed to preach the Gospel and to make disciples of all nations in the name of Jesus Christ.

AGMP is funded solely through gifts and annual dues given by each member organization. AGMP holds two meetings annually in North America to promote collaboration in mission and is guided by a steering committee selected by lot from the partners.

AGMP invites like-minded organizations to apply to affiliate with AGMP. Applications will be reviewed by AGMP's membership committee. 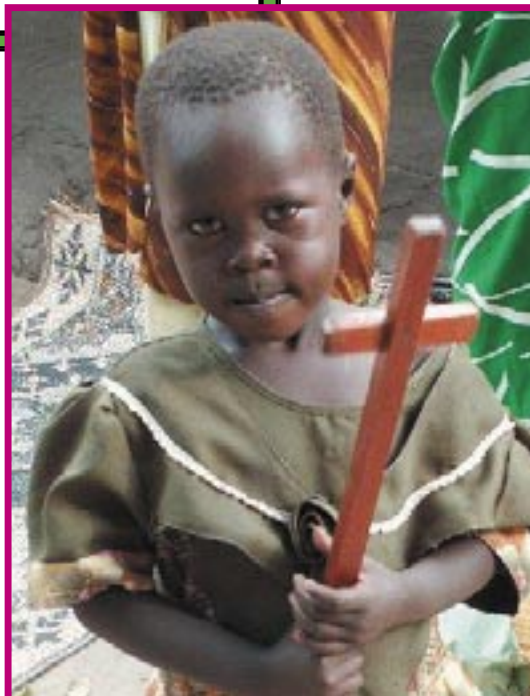

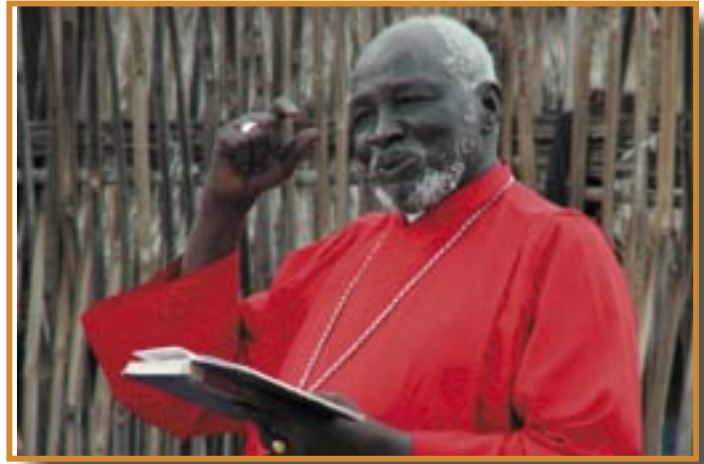

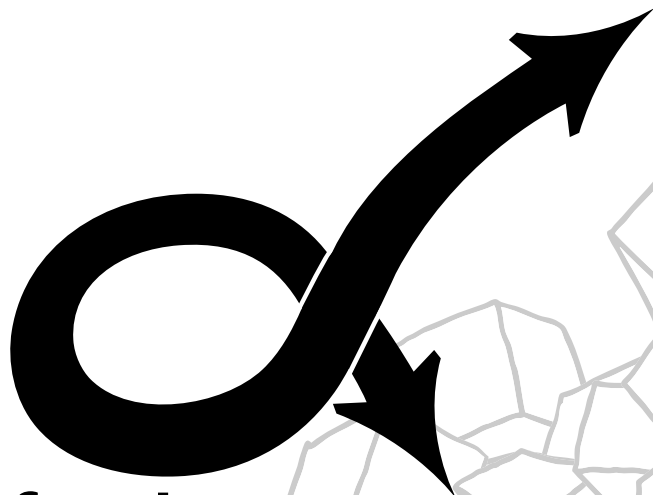
